### 2009 NISSAN GT-R

The all-new 2009 Nissan GT-R is no longer the unobtainable object of desire on a video game or in the movies, the GT-R is now on sale for the first time in North America.

The Nissan GT-R is built on an exclusive all-new Premium Midship platform. This platform enables the use of a world's first independent rear transaxle ATTESA E-TS all-wheel drive system, which optimizes weight distribution and handling capability.

This layout places the transmission, transfer case and final drive at the rear of the vehicle, without the use of traditional torque tubes, allowing the suspension to operate independently and optimizing tire grip at each corner.

The 2009 GT-R features an all-new hand-built 3.8-liter twin turbo V6 producing 480 horsepower and 430 lb.-ft. of torque.

Handling duties are managed by a 4-wheel independent suspension system mounted to high-precision six-point front and rear sub frames.

Stopping power is provided by Brembo mono block six-piston front and four piston rear calipers with large 15-inch Brembo full-floating cross-drilled two piece rotors and low-steel high-stiffness brake pads.

GT-R-specific lightweight forged 20-inch wheels are shod with nitrogen-filled Bridgestone high-performance summer run-flat tires specifically designed for the GT-R.
